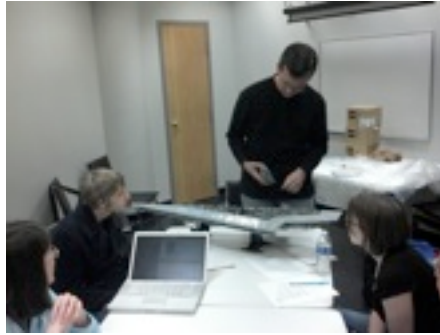

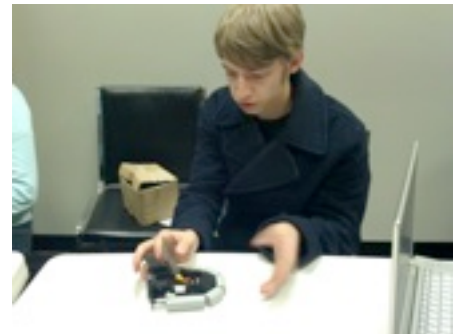

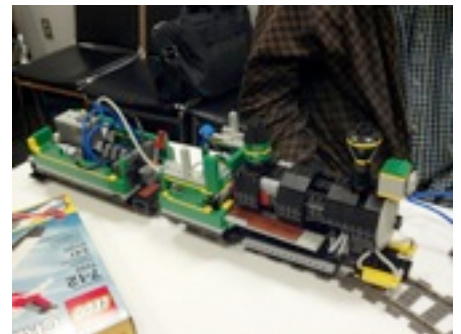
Pete presenting the Super Star Destroyer and time lapse video of the build
